**Oak Grove's Winter Sports Programs for Grades K-6
January 11th and 18th and February 1st and 8th**

Ice Skating - Nelson Withington Rink at Living Memorial Park. Includes skate rental if needed and transportation. Beginning skaters should wear a helmet. Transportation is by bus. *(45 student limit)* **Grades K-6**

Sledding - Living Memorial Park. Includes transportation which is by bus. *(40 student limit)* **Grades K-6**

Downhill Skiing & Snowboarding - Mount Snow. A wonderful opportunity to learn or gain new skills in skiing or snowboarding. Students will enjoy a 1 hour lesson and then free ski time guided by chaperones. Includes rentals (if needed), lessons, lift ticket, and transportation by bus. Helmets are mandatory and are not part of the rental package. *(40 student limit)* **Grades 3-6**

BEEC Winter Wonderland - Living Memorial Park. Come explore the world of winter. You'll investigate animal winter survival strategies, birds in the wintertime, animal tracking, camouflage, finding shelter, animal relationships, and play games that mimic their winter behavior. Includes instruction from a BEEC representative and transportation by bus. *(20 student limit)* **Grades K-3**

XC Skiing - Brattleboro Outing Club. Discover the thrill of skiing over hills and down, learn by playing games on skis, trying zany drills and exploring forest trails. Includes rentals, if needed and transportation by bus. *(40 student limit)* **Grades K-6**

Backyard Winter Games - Join us outdoors around Oak Grove School as we explore our surroundings and have fun. Activities will include snow shoeing, fort building, nature walks, crafts and cooking. Includes supplies needed for the different activities. *(30 student limit)* **Grades PK-6**
